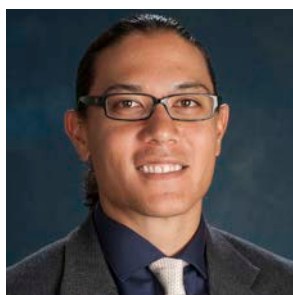
**ANNE T. VO, PHD**
