David Muhammad



David Muhammad is the incoming Chief Probation Officer of the Alameda County Probation Department. David's Department is responsible for overseeing 17,000 people on probation, a staff of 620, and a \$90 million budget. After working in both New York and Washington DC, David returns to his hometown to continue reforming the criminal justice system in the Bay Area. Muhammad was formally the Executive Director of The Mentoring Center in Oakland, CA. In honor of his work with youth, Muhammad received the 2000 Community Leadership Award and Fellowship from The California Wellness Foundation, honoring community leaders who are involved in violence prevention. In 2002, he was awarded the prestigious Next Generation Leadership Award from The Rockefeller Foundation.
