Dual Enrollment Participation from 9th to 12th Grade

As described in [A Strong Start for College and Career](#), dual enrollment is a key strategy for increasing equitable access to postsecondary education and improving readiness for college. In general, participation in dual enrollment has been increasing. However, large gaps persist by race/ethnicity. Also of concern, English learners, students with disabilities, foster and homeless youth lag their peers in dual enrollment participation. To address these gaps, California policymakers and advocates are working with K-12 and community college educators to increase participation and to ensure that dual enrollment opportunities are more equitably available to and accessed by students earlier in high school. This online appendix provides a closer look at the variation in rates of dual enrollment across local educational agencies (LEA) in California's 58 counties.

Data and Methods

Statistics provided in this appendix draw on analysis of matched data from two sources:

- Student-level enrollment data from the California Department of Education (CDE) for the census of 9th through 12th graders enrolled in a California LEA (defined as a county office of education, a public school district, or a charter school) during the 2021-22 academic year.
- Student-level course enrollment data between summer 2021 and spring 2022 from the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO).

By merging data from both segments, we identify all public high school students in grades 9 through 12 who enroll in at least one community college course, whether through formalized programs or independently.

In the county-specific tables that follow, we provide dual enrollment participation rates during the 2021-22 academic year overall, by grade level, and for key subgroups for all students in each county and by LEA in each county. For some counties and LEAs, statistics are omitted due to reporting restrictions for small cell sizes; these omissions are denoted by ***.

The rates provided in these tables may differ from other published work due to differences in sample restrictions and/or cohort composition.
