Scholarship/Grant

For the Credential year, the School of Education offers a number of scholarships and grants to well-prepared applicants who apply by **January 15th**. Masters year funding is awarded at the end of the Credential year.

Cal Grant

Undergraduate Cal Grant A and B receipients who plan to enroll in a teaching credential program (TCP) after they receive their bachelor's degree *may be eligible* to renew their Cal Grant award for an additional year. You will need to work with the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) to verify eligibility and submit the <u>G-44 Form</u> (Request for Cal Grant Teaching Credential Program Benefits) to request benefits. Golden State Teacher Grant Program

The <u>Golden State Teacher Grant Program</u> (GSTG) awards **up to \$10,000** to students currently enrolled in a professional preparation program approved by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) and working towards earning their preliminary teaching credential. Loans

There are a variety of loan options to help you fund your education. Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or the California Dream Act Application (**CADAA**) allows the university to determine what types of financial aid you qualify for. When completing your financial aid application, in section "Plans and Educational Background" under degree or certificate, select **Grad/Professional program** – not teacher credential. In the "Dependency" section make sure to mark **yes** for Grad/Professional. The **UC Davis school code is 001313**.
